



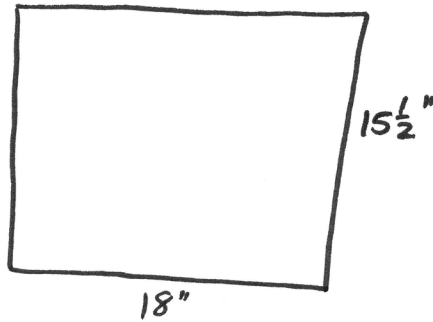
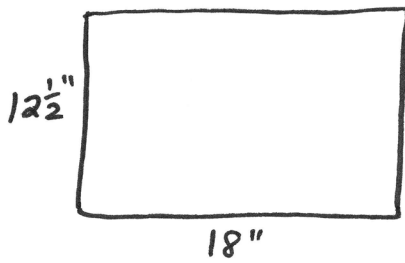
Easy Button Fabric Gift Bags

Materials Needed:

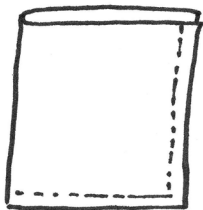
2 coordinating fabrics...



Plus:

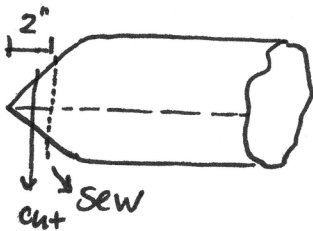
Approx. 18" ribbon or 4" elastic cord

One button



1. Fold both fabrics in half along the 18" length, right sides together.

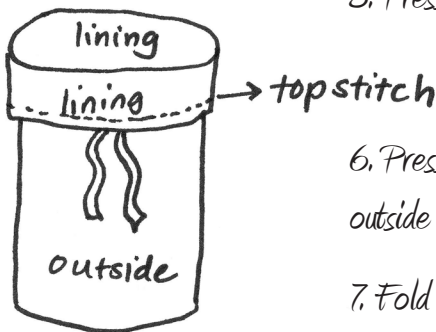
2. Sew bottom and side seams of each.



3. Box corners by pulling out on the sides of the bag and lining up the side and bottom seams. Sew across the triangle created at about 2" from the point. Then cut off the tip.

4. Turn the outside bag right side out.

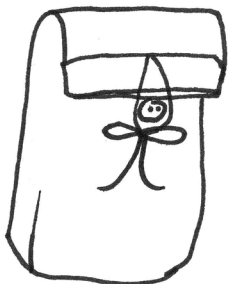
5. Press the top edge of the lining down 1/4" hem, then insert into the outside bag.



6. Press down the top of the lining one more time for a larger hem that overlaps the outside of the bag by at least 1/4".

7. Fold the ribbon in half and insert the folded end between the lining and outside of the bag at least 1/2". Sew the hem.

8. Sew button to the center of the opposite side of the bag from the ribbon at about 5" down from the top.



To use bag: insert a gift, flatten the top closed and fold it down until just above the button. Tie the ribbon around the button to close...cute!
