



Handmade little quilts and quilted things **by Emma Thomas-McGinnis**

Quilts on your walls add warmth and texture to a room. These miniature quilts I call “Quilties” are a great little size to group with other kinds of art and add a little personality to a small room. They’re also a great size for gift-giving.



Commissioned Quilt Projects

Sometimes an occasion or a loved one calls for a very special gift, such that only a quilt big enough for cuddling will do. A lap quilt, sized perfectly to cover an adult or throw over the side of a couch, tells the recipient that you care about their comfort. A larger quilt for a bed makes a wonderful present for a child growing up into a big-kid bed, a young adult going off to college or a couple getting married.



Size and complexity will determine the cost of the quilt commission. I will work with you to determine the best approach to the design of the quilt, choice of fabrics and timeline for your project. We can consider using clothing from a loved one, t-shirts, photo transfers, embroidery or specific choices of fabric designs or colors to make your quilt unique. Materials and workmanship are priced separately, and will be estimated before beginning the project. Estimated materials cost will be due upon ordering, workmanship fee and any remaining materials cost will be due before delivery of the finished quilt.

At your request you can be as involved in the process of designing and making the quilt as you’d like to be, from shopping with me to approving sketches and seeing progress photos, or just leaving it all up me...either way, as I designer I know how to make the quilt suit you and your recipient perfectly, not necessarily my tastes!

Commissioned Quilt Details

I would like to discuss all the details of your desired quilt project with you before nailing down the price. However, I understand that before we take the time to do that we should know if we are on the same page about budget figures. So, the following is a good guideline for pricing. It is based on a medium-complexity quilt, with some special features, and simple quilting design in an allover or follow-the-quilt style.

Workmanship Fee

Quiltie – custom-designed quiltie with hand-embroidered center (up to 10" x 14")	\$40
Large Wall-hanging – from 20" square to 40" longest side	\$150 +materials
Lap-size Quilt – large enough to cover an adult sitting down (approx.45"x55)	\$200 +materials
Twin-size Bed Quilt (65"x88")	\$300 +materials
Queen-size Bed Quilt (86"x93")	\$375 +materials

Materials Estimates

These estimates are based on large retail store prices (JoAnn's or Hancock's) with some quilt store fabric optional. Retail store quality is quite sufficient for a long-lasting, well-constructed quilt and I inspect all the fabric before purchasing to ensure good texture, weight and printing. Quilt store-quality only would be about 200% these estimates. Materials estimate is due up-front for purchasing purposes. Receipts will be provided after purchase and remainder due or remaining balance will be applied to the workmanship fee upon quilt delivery.

Large Wall-hanging – from 20" square to 40" longest side	\$30
Lap-size Quilt – large enough to cover an adult sitting down (approx.45"x55)	\$70
Twin-size Bed Quilt (65"x88")	\$90
Queen-size Bed Quilt (86"x93")	\$100

Note: If your quilt involves using clothing or t-shirts, materials will cost less.
